Good Afternoon Caledonia Elementary Families,

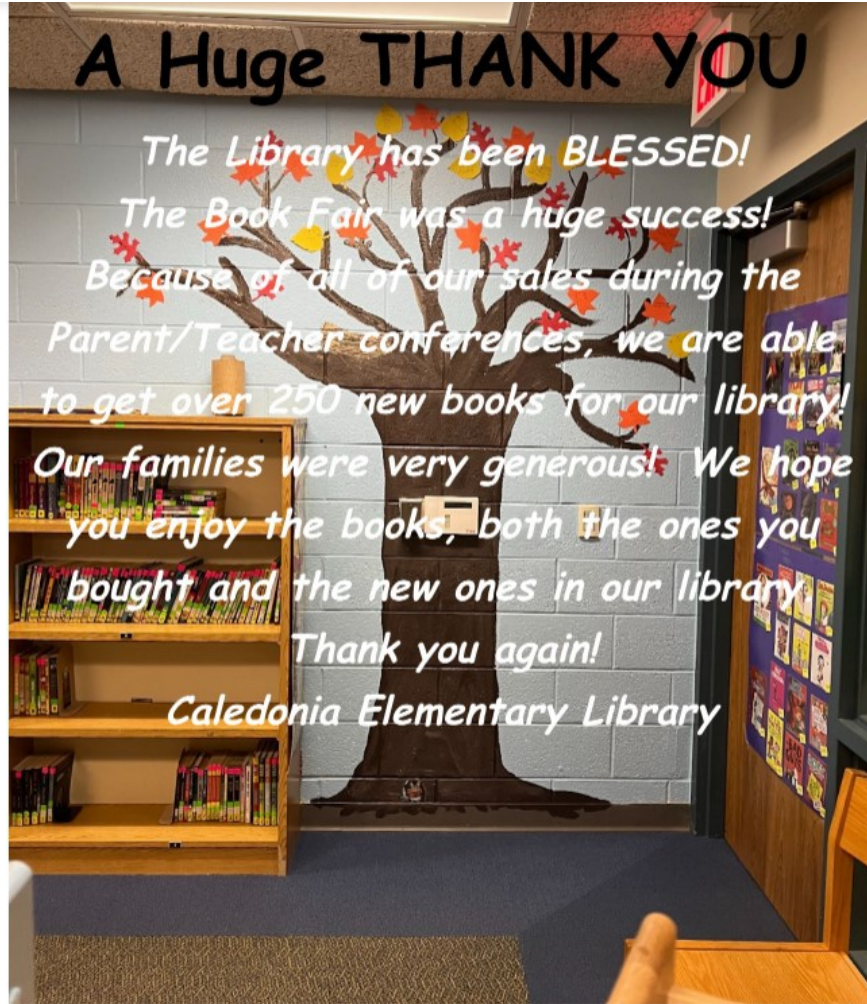
Thank you to all families that joined us during conferences this week. A strong school/home partnership is a critical component of student success and we appreciate your support!

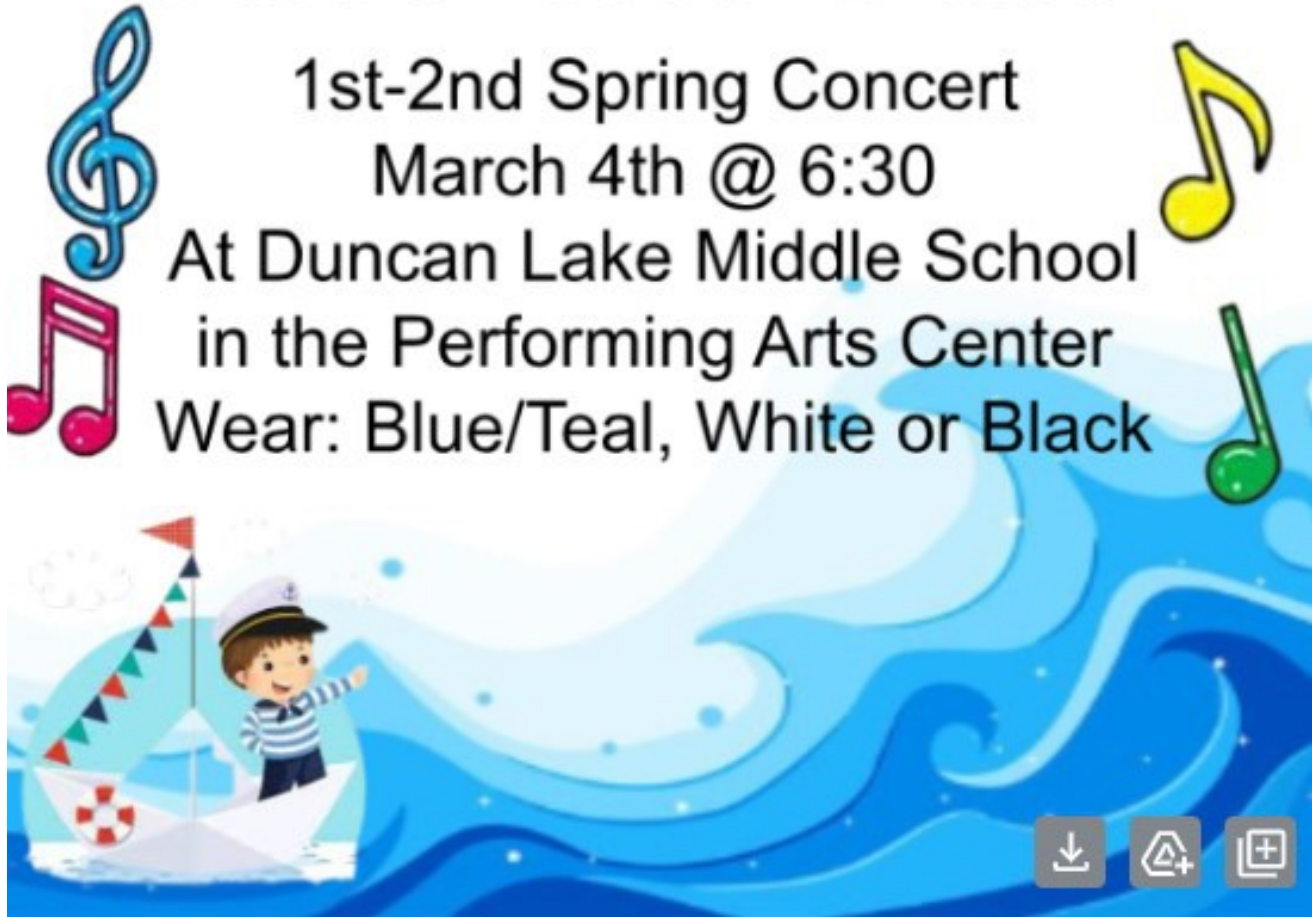
