Call to order and welcome

Meeting called to order at 12:09.

Old Business

New Business

- Odyssey of the Mind 2017/2018
 - It was discussed that if OM would like to join EnrichED the committee feels like it needs to be District wide or none at all. Kris will talk with Randy about this and what we should do. The Elementary Schools and High School OM teams would have approached EnrichED about combining efforts and bringing OM under the EnrichED umbrella. There was discussion that the Middle School may be open to it and Kris will talk with Randy on how to handle or approach this.

Tech room at KMMS and the Old Shop room at DLMS

- VEX is looking at purchasing another field and to fit it into the Tech room they would need to move some of the old shop equipment to fit the field into the space. There are several groups that use this space and it would be good to get them all together and discuss how best to use this space and if anything needs to move to Duncan Lake Middle School.
- Kelly will work to set meeting with Admin/teachers in the spring to discuss the spaces at both Middle Schools and plan a work day this summer to clean up spaces as needed.

New Donations Received/Funding Requests:

- Caledonia Education Foundation grant received for \$2400 from fall submission request for upgraded technology, including 10 WeDo2.0 kits and 10 WeDo2.0 power packs.
- Financial Report (see attached budget updated through 1/31/17):
 - Future purchase = 10 WeDo2.0 kits and power packs = \$2400
 - Future purchase: 10 BLED112 bluetooth dongles (necessary for WeDo2.0 operation) = \$12.31 x 10 = \$123.10 from Newegg
 - Future purchase: 10 laptop bags (to provide protection for donated laptops leaving the Tech Room) = \$15 x 10 = \$150 from Amazon

■ 2017 Season Planning:

- Will likely kick off the season in May as the WeDo2.0 kits cannot be ordered until teams are registered. Software will need to be loaded and laptops configured over the summer months.

 - New Grants applying for this year and reapplying for others we got last year. (Feb - May)
 - Better ways to order/manage parts for teams.
 - Contracts with students at beginning of year on how to use the space.
 - Teams for next year may look different for MS/HS. MS will get a committee together to help form teams.
 - No parent night/information night. So much interest right now and lots more coming up from FLL that we will just open up Registration in May and form teams after that.
- Becky Sowerby has been doing an amazing job letting 8th graders know about VEX and seeing a lot of new interest because of that.
- VEX attended the 8th grade parent night and set up a table. Lots of students stopped by that night and gained a lot of interest.
- Beth asked the board for approval of the purchases made to send two VEX teams to the state Tournament. Kelly Motioned to approve paying for it and Stephanie seconded the motion.
 - Caledonia VEX has decided it will pay for \$120 in tournaments for the year and if any team makes it to state they will pay those tournament fees as well. If any teams make it to worlds it will be the responsibility of the team to raise money for this entry fee.
