Item

Call to order and welcome
The meeting was called to order at 12:01pm.

Old Business

- Approval of Minutes from last meeting
 - Beth motioned to approve the minutes and Kelly seconded the motion.
- Clarification of May, 2016 minutes "teams"
 - May 2016 Minutes stated:
 - Odyssey of the Mind It was discussed that there may be a need to move the Elementary & High School OM teams under the EnrichED umbrella. This past year there were some difficulties in both programs and some members feel if it was moved under EnrichED it may run more smoothly. Randy was not opposed to moving OM at the High School and Elementary levels if this is what they really wanted. Teams will not be forced to join but if they are asking to join EnrichED it can be considered. Stephanie/Beth will reach out to OM leaders at the High School and Elementary and set up a meeting to see if this is what they would like to do.
 - The board would like to clarify the intent of this discussion held back in May 2016. The word "teams" should have read "Committees". The intent of this discussion was to show that we'd not force Entire Committees(Ie: OM, Science Olympiad, Math Olympiad, etc) to come under the Entire umbrella but if they did we'd take them as an entire group. It was not meant for individual teams to pick and choose if they'd come under the EnrichED

umbrella. If it was decided a group(Committee) wanted to come under EnrichED, all teams in that program would come along with it and follow the policies and procedures set forth by EnrichED.

 Beth motioned to approve the change and Kelly seconded the motion.

New Business

- Odyssey of the Mind 2017/2018
 - Coordinator(s)
 - We are excited to announce two new coordinators for OM have joined as of August 2017. Kathy Sebel, Christine Flodin
- <u>Caledonia EnrichED Guidelines</u> & supporting documents including:
 - The EnrichED Guidelines(see attached) has been created to help serve as a guide for new and existing Coordinators. As we brought on OM this past summer, it was evident a document was needed to help guide Coordinators on policies and procedures. This document was presented today as a draft. Beth made a motion to adopt this document as a guideline for EnrichED. This can be modified year to year as needed. Below is a list of highlights contained within the document.

 - Beth motioned to approve the guidelines and Kelly seconded the motion.

 - Jr FLL

2017 Season Update shared by Wendy Cammet:

- Currently wrapping up our 2017 fall season, concluding with Saturday's Expo
- Nine teams this season, with two from every school except Paris Ridge, which has one team combined with some Emmons students. We have two non-district students this year as well, one from Dutton Christian and one home schooled.
- 51 students participating this year, up from 41 in 2016 (participation up 20% year over year.) Almost all of participants are 3rd graders, with the exception of three 1st graders.
- Registration is now closed
- Nine new WeDo2.0 kits were purchased and are in use along with the donated laptops, positive feedback from teams about what this adds to the experience
- One scholarship granted this year, parent is coaching
- Practices started 9/4 and will conclude this week, moving up our season also positively received by parents and coaches who appreciate ending before the holidays
- Season ending Expo scheduled for Nov 18 at Kraft Meadows, working on last minute details now, first time holding a "local only" Expo vs a FIRST sponsored event
- Beth short judge meeting/training?
- Season wrap up hoping to collect all equipment by Dec 1
- Will want to remember to advertise our May info night to our incoming 2nd and 3rd graders to bridge that gap in our participation levels (send home individual flyers)
- It was discussed that JR FLL may want to look at next year moving EXPO to a Friday night to save on Facility Fees and miss FLL tournaments.

VEX

Beth & Kelly shared these updates on VEX:

- Separation
 - Beth reached out to Brady Lake about a space for High School VEX teams at Caledonia High School. On Halloween the High School packed up ½ of the VEX equipment and moved it over to their new space at the High School.
 - This transition will take some time and further meetings to figure out how to share the space, parts and finances evenly amongst the MS/HS teams.
- MS Only League Updates
 - Caledonia VEX Robotics kicked off its very first ever League event on 11/6. We have held two League nights so far; One at Caledonia & One at Grandville. Both have gone really well and we have received a lot of compliments about our facility and how the league has been run. Grandville has once again been a huge help to get this new adventure kicked off.
 - Several parents have volunteered to help get the league night going and we could not have done this without them.
 - We are excited about what this can do for our Robotics programs.
- Several Tournaments in Dec/Jan.
 - Both the MS/HS teams are competing in several tournaments starting in December. Most are attending Grandville or Jenison Tournaments.
- Skills event 2/2
 - We will be hosting our first ever skills event on February 2 at KMMS. This will be a great opportunity for teams to have one last chance to up their scores at a chance to advance to State.
- STEAM Night at Kettle Lake January 18 5:30-7:30
 - We are hoping to send some JR, FLL and/or VEX teams to the STEAM night at Kettle Lake. This is a great opportunity for kids to be exposed to our Robotics programs.
- OM
 - Odyssey of the Mind (OM) is still working to form teams.
 They have several registered and paid, but they still have a few teams they are trying to finalize. At this time it looks like there will be representation from every building in the District (4 ELEM, 3 MS, 1 HS)
 - OM coordinators went to a training last weekend and have

- lots of good information to share with Coaches. They will be updating coaches soon with this information and will register teams once they have all paid.
- EnrichED board discussed that it would be a good idea for each team to be given a budget of what they can spend on materials. The OM coordinators will look into this.

 - Beth made a motion to approve this, and Kelly seconded the motion.
- Vote on any proposed purchases
 - VEX Team Tournament/League Fees \$1600
 - Kelly made a motion to approve these purchase, and Beth seconded the motion.

 - Kelly met with Bidergy & Gary to help figure out what equipment could be auctioned off from the KMMS tech room. Bidergy came out last week to start tagging equipment to auction.
