ESSER III federal funds: estimated to receive \$5.4 million to be spent during the 2022-23 & 2023-24 school years

- 1) very specific use of funds
 - a) designated for one-time or short-term expenditures
 - b) must address the disproportionate impact of the pandemic specific to at-risk / disadvantaged students in our district defined as: **low income, diverse racial & ethnic groups, English language learners, students with disabilities and homeless, migrant and foster care students**
